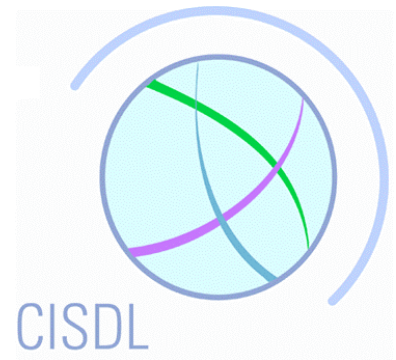

The Predominant Biodiversity Issues

- **Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) complementary to the goals of the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) that do not conflict with the Trade Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights (TRIPS)**
- **The TRIPS-CBD relationship after the Fourth Ministerial Conference of the World Trade Organization (WTO) in Doha**
- **Access and benefit sharing (ABS) rules and practices**
- **Protection of indigenous knowledge (IK) - especially issues related to article 8j of the CBD**
